### **Safety Guidelines**

### Emergencies

 $\triangle$  The product is not intended to be an emergency call device or sole communication aid.

### Contaminants

 $\triangle$  To prevent ingestion of bacteria, dust, and dirt, do not allow the user to chew on the product.

### Cleaning, Maintaining, and Servicing

- ▲ Do not attempt to disassemble, service, or repair the product. Only a technician will be able to disassemble the product and replace a part. If a product component or accessory is damaged, call Service for assistance.
- △ Use a microfiber (lint-free) cleaning cloth to wipe the product. Never use abrasives or coarse cleaning cloths.
- ▲ If the product needs more than a dry wipe-down, dampen this cloth or another lint-free cloth. Damp means wrung out, never dripping. Dry the product thoroughly with a dry lint-free cloth.
- ▲ VersaEye: If the transparent area gets smeary or visibly dirty, place a small amount of rubbing alcohol on a lint-free cloth and gently wipe it. Polish the area with a dry part of your cloth.

### Accessories

- $\triangle$  Do not use accessories, detachable parts, or materials not described in the instructions for use.
- $\triangle$  Do not use accessories, detachable parts, or materials in any other way than described in the instructions for use.

### Small Parts, Cords, Cables, and Straps

- ▲ Cords, cables, and straps are potential entanglement or strangulation hazards. Please consider this prior to placing these items with users.
- ▲ On a regular basis, visually inspect cables, cords, and connectors for damage or wear, especially where they are subject to extra stress. Cables and cords can become frayed or damaged from heavy use or with age. For example, a frayed cable could cause a battery charger/power adapter to short-circuit, posing a hazard to the user.

### Charging

#### Volume/Hearing

- ▲ Prolonged exposure to loud sounds can lead to tinnitus. Stop using the product if the user experiences ringing or buzzing in the ears.
- ▲ To set volume to a safe level, adjust the volume to a low setting and then slowly increase the sound until the user can hear it comfortably and clearly.

### **Attaching Versa Products**

A Be sure to follow the Safety Guidelines and instructions if you attach a VersaEye or VersaSpeaker to a VersaWrap. Failure to install products according to the instructions may result in an injury to the user.

### VersaEye: Mounting and Positioning

- ▲ Any mounts used should be fitted by a qualified person. Failure to install the mounting system according to the manufacturer's instructions may result in an injury to the user. Be certain that the user's view is not obstructed by the mounting.
- △ Analysis of positioning by a qualified person is required to prevent repetitive stress injuries to the user.
- △ Consult your vision care provider about product positioning for the user.

### VersaEye: Fatigue

- ▲ While the user is getting used to eye tracking, take frequent breaks to rest the user's eyes and relax his or her concentration.
- ▲ Some people may experience a certain amount of fatigue (due to intentional eye focusing and hard concentration) or even a dryness of the eyes (due to less frequent blinking) when first getting used to eye tracking. If you are experiencing fatigue or dry eyes, start off slowly and limit the length of your eye tracking sessions to your comfort level. Moisturizing eye drops can be helpful to combat dryness.

### VersaEye: Seizures

▲ Some people may have epileptic seizures triggered by light flashes or patterns. This may occur while presented successive pictures or video material, even if they have never had a seizure before. Observe the individual using the product. Move the person away from the system immediately and consult a physician if the individual shows the following or similar symptoms: involuntary movements, disorientation, convulsions, loss of awareness, or altered vision.

### VersaEye: Infrared Emissions

▲ Your eye tracking system uses infrared (IR) technology. Certain medical devices are susceptible to disturbance by IR emissions. Do not use the eye tracking system when in the vicinity of such susceptible medical devices. If you have questions about the susceptibility of a medical device, consult the manufacturer of the medical device or your health care provider.

### VersaEye: Implantable Medical Devices

A minimum of six (6) inches should be maintained between a wireless product and an implantable medical device, such as a pacemaker, implantable cardioverter defibrillator, vagus nerve stimulator, shunt, or stent, to avoid potential magnetic interference with the medical device. Persons who have such devices:


- Should ALWAYS keep the product a minimum of six (6) inches from their implantable medical device;
- Should not carry the product in a breast pocket;
- Should move the product away from themselves immediately if there is any reason to suspect that it is interfering with the implantable medical device;
- Should read and follow the directions from the manufacturer of the implantable medical device. If you have any questions about using the product with an implantable medical device, consult your health care provider.

### VersaWrap: Apple AirTag (sold separately)

- ▲ If you attach an Apple AirTag<sup>®</sup> to keep track of personal items from the VersaWrap, the AirTag poses security risks. Go to https://support.apple.com/en-us/119874 and read the article "What to do if you get an alert that an AirTag, set of AirPods, Find My network accessory, or compatible Bluetooth location-tracking device is with you".
- ▲ If you attach an Apple AirTag to your VersaWrap, the AirTag, battery cover, and battery are potential choking hazards, especially to small children.

### VersaEye System Overview

The VersaEye<sup>™</sup> eye tracking system tracks eye movement, allowing individuals with restricted muscle control to fully access communication software. VersaEye uses the camera on the Hiru eye tracking module by IRISBOND to translate the individual's eye movements into pointer movements and activations/selections on the screen of the individual's iPad<sup>®</sup>. The eye tracking module attaches to the iPad, which can then be mounted to a wheelchair or table stand.




### VersaEye Power Button and LEDs

- 1 green LED: Powering ON
- 1 red LED: Powering OFF
- 🔋 Battery status: Tap 🔿
- All 3 LEDs lit if 60% or higher
- 2 LEDs lit if below 60%
- Only 1 LED lit if below 30%

### Charging

- 1 LED flashing: charging
- 1 LED solid: fully charged



### **Cleaning and Disinfecting**

To get the most from your Versa product, keep it clean and disinfected.

- 1. Turn off all attached equipment.
- 2. Wipe with a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water.

**Important:** Do not spray or splash liquid on the equipment or immerse it in liquid.

- 3. Dry with another soft, lint-free cloth.
- 4. Moisten a clean cloth in a solution of 1/4 cup of vinegar and 1 cup of water.
- 5. Wipe down all surfaces and clean inside all cracks and corners.


Important: Do not use vinegar and water on any display or lens (if applicable).

### If more than one person uses the product:


- Wipe down the product with disinfectant wipes (Virucidal, Bactericidal, Pseudomonacidal, Tuberculocidal, Fungicidal)—Metrex CaviWipes<sup>™</sup>.
- 2. Clean inside all cracks and corners and wipe more than once if necessary to keep the product wet for at least three minutes.
- 3. Allow the product to dry.

### Connect VersaEye to an iPad

1. Set the bottom of the iPad at angle and insert the right corner.



- 2. Press the left bottom corner into place.
- 3. Carefully work the upper right corner of the iPad into the case, followed by the upper left corner.
- 4. Insert the USB-C cable from the VersaEye into the USB-C port of the iPad.



5. Start your iPad.


### Set up Eye Tracking

- 1. Connect to Wi-Fi<sup>®</sup>.
- 2. Open the App Store<sup>®</sup> and search for **IRISBOND Hiru**.
- 3. Select GET.



Important: Do not select Open yet.

4. Connect the charger to the VersaEye port. This will charge the VersaEye batteries and your iPad.



- △ While the device is charging, touching the surface of the device with broken skin may aggravate a wound.
- ⚠ While the device is charging, infants or high-risk groups should not touch the surface of the device if there is a chance of burning the skin.
- 5. Turn VersaEye on by holding the power button for three seconds.
- 6. Select Open.




7. The Hiru app opens.



- 8. If the yellow **Update Hiru** button appears, go to the iOS **Settings**, select **Display & Brightness**, and set Auto-Lock to Never during updates.
- 9. Return to the Hiru app, select **Update Hiru**, and proceed with the update.
- 10. When the update is complete, restart the iPad and VersaEye module.

### **Position the User**


- ☑ Analysis of positioning by a qualified person is suggested to ensure proper use and setup of the Hiru module.
- $\square$  The user's eyes should be looking into the upper third of the screen.



- ✓ Position the user approximately 20-22 inches (51-56 cm) from the device screen. Actual distance may vary from user to user or if you wear glasses.
- ✓ If the camera sees your pupils (which are used for tracking) the white light will appear on top of the module. If you look around the screen, this light should remain stable and always lit you are using the Hiru module. If you see flicker with this light, adjust your positioning.
- ☑ If someone is sitting beside the user, try to position the device to face the user as much as possible. If the camera detects the other person's eyes, the eye tracking system will choose whichever eyes it sees most clearly.

### **Calibrate Eye Tracking**

The number of Calibration Points determines the number of stimulus points you will look at during calibration. The more points you follow accurately, the more accurate control the user will gain over more of the screen.



## **Adjust Smoothing**

Smoothing changes the sensitivity of the cursor.

- Lower values will be more sensitive to eye and head movements.
- Higher values will be less sensitive to eye and head movements.



### **Make Selections with iOS Dwell Control**

When you turn on Dwell Control in the iOS Settings, holding the cursor still on an item for a specified time selects the item.

- 1. Go to the iOS Settings and select Accessibility > Touch > AssistiveTouch.
- 2. Turn on **Dwell Control**.



- 3. Select Movement Tolerance and adjust the distance the cursor can move while dwelling on an item.
- 4. Adjust Dwell Time.

### Make Selections with a Switch

You can use a Bluetooth<sup>®</sup> wireless switch or a 3.5 mm wired switch to make selections.

1. Connect a wireless switch to the VersaEye module via Bluetooth or plug a wired switch into the 3.5 mm port in the module.



- 2. Move the cursor to the item you want using your eyes.
- 3. Activate the switch to tap, double-tap, or hold and drag.
